

BARRINGTON

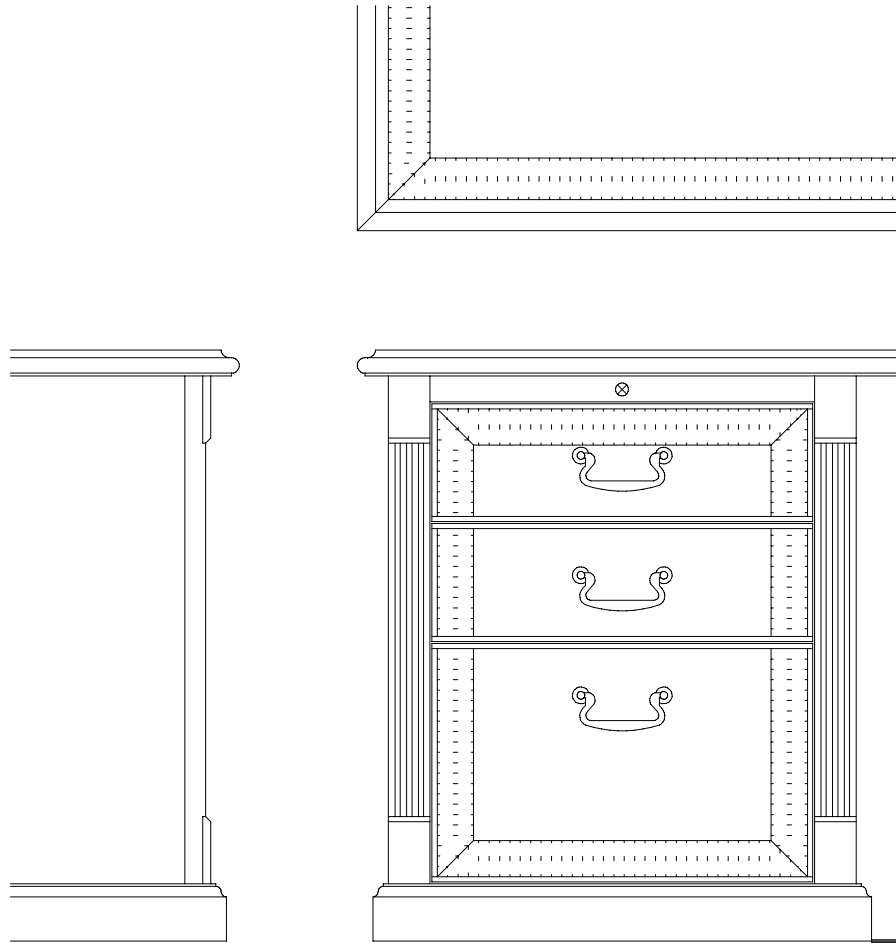
Barrington is a traditionally trimmed and detailed product design. The worksurface is 1¼" thick with a reverse ogee edge, supported by a detailed pedestal with 2¾" mitered plinth base. All edges are mitered in the corners. Where return and bridge tops join a desk and credenza worksurface, the edge is interrupted and continued with an inside mitered connection. This allows a smooth transition between worksurfaces. A stepped and fluted stile trims the vertical elements on the approach of the desk, the end panels of door and drawer units, and the vertical panels on upper storage components. The tops of high-rise storage units and anchors have a 3" crown molding to complete the traditional detailing. The approach side of the desk has a stepped modesty panel, and the back of credenzas and storage units are flush, finished and do not include the base detail. The finish on the pulls is bright brass. Black locks are standard on all drawers and are keyed alike by set-up.

This price list allows a certain amount of flexibility with the drawer storage components. The box-box-file pedestals (6-6-12) indicated with the letter A and the file-file (12-12) indicated with the letter B are interchangeable. Within the model number, the letters after the dimensional numbers communicate the drawer configuration. These letters indicate the sequence and type of drawer storage on the unit. The A and B pedestals are interchangeable at the same price.

The overall dimensions indicated throughout this price list for each item include the projection of the edge and crown moulding details. When components are configured together to form larger assemblies, this projected detail is eliminated but the body of the unit remains the same. Therefore the overall combined dimension of a configuration will not be the sum of the single unit's dimensions. This assures a transition between components that is tight and free of gaps. Contact the factory for exact dimensions if overall size of a configured unit is required.

BARRINGTON LE

Barrington LE is an enhanced version of Barrington that introduces accent borders of quartered figured Limba on primary panels throughout the product offering. This border provides a subtle contrast between the plain sliced bookmatched Cherry infield and the traditionally detailed solid wood trim. Each horizontal worksurface has a 2" short grain border which forms a complete mitered frame. When worksurfaces are connected, the border pattern is continuous on each top even though the edge detail is interrupted for flush transitions between tops. This develops a double border at the connecting joints. Multiple piece table tops have a mitered 3" short grain border at the perimeter edges only to assist the table top in appearing to be one piece. A mitered 1 3/4" short grain border is utilized on the vertical approach panels of the desks and the doors and drawer fronts of all units. The standard configuration of these borders is determined by the locations of the vertical pilaster details. Typically there will be one border pattern within the space established by the vertical pilasters. The Barrington LE reception desk has a mitered 2 1/4" short grain border on the front approach panels and mitered 1 3/4" short grain border on the transaction tops. The reception desk worksurfaces, reception desk drawer fronts and the pilastered table bases DO NOT have the short grain border pattern included in the price. The Barrington LE price column reflects the borders as located in the above descriptions. If a different application of the accent border is required than what is outlined in this pricelist, please contact the factory to discuss the desired placement of the borders and the corresponding price, whether on the tops or vertical panels.



There are a selected number of upper storage units that have individual lite true mullion doors with 1/8" clear antique glass. These doors provide added traditional detailing to the complete Barrington design. The glass doors have mitered solid wood frames that match the body of the unit on the standard Barrington pieces. The Barrington LE glass doors feature the accent quartered figured Limba short grain veneers on the door frames. The glass door enclosures have adjustable wood shelving included in the price that can be enhanced with optional recessed lighting and optional adjustable glass shelving to provide display storage.

Selected pieces of both Barrington and Barrington LE have available optional 3 piece leather insert tops. The sections of the leather top are divided by 2" solid wood battens. The standard Barrington desk tops with leather insert tops have a 3 1/2" solid ogee edge trim. The leather insert tops on Barrington LE products have 2 1/2" Limba border between the solid ogee edge and the leather insert panels.
